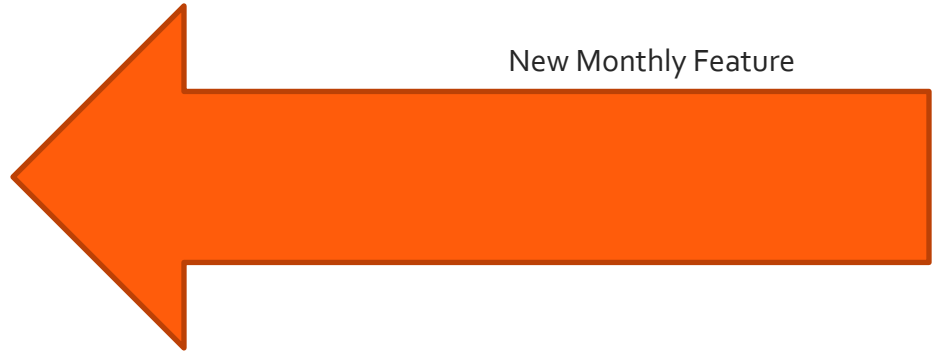
Cheryl Lewis?

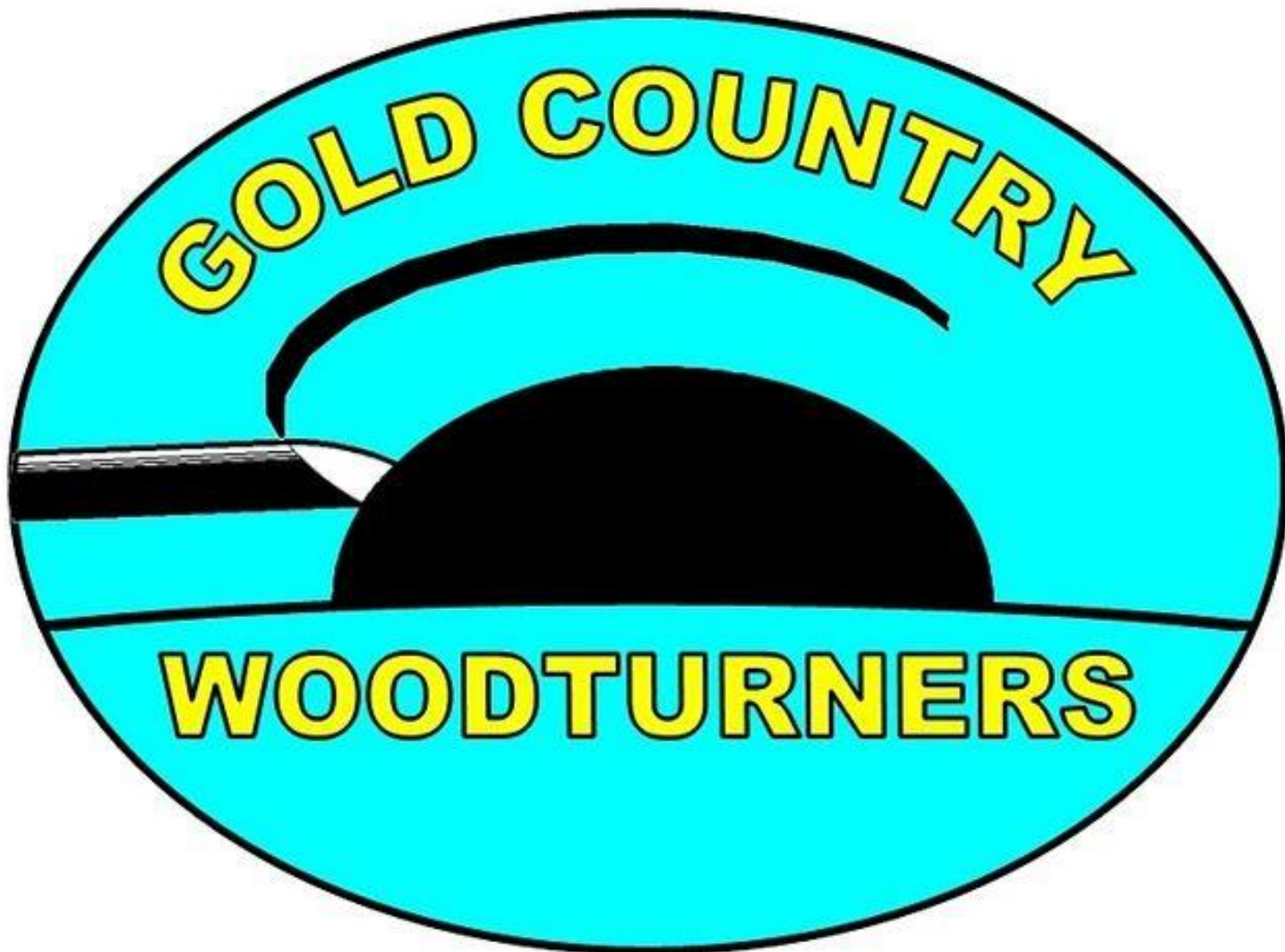
